



Covid-19 Preparedness Measures and Requirements for Participation

Spacing, Capacity, Numbers

- Capacity is limited based on available space and ability to social distance with six feet between teachers/participants, except in facilities where instructor/student must be in close proximity (i.e. dance instruction)
- For class settings, work areas will be set up before arrival of students, allowing at least a six foot radius around users.
- Excess seating has been removed throughout the facility to discourage lingering.
- If necessary, class sizes will be reduced to accommodate the required six feet of social distancing.
- CCAC's Lost and Found bins have been eliminated – items left after class will be disposed of.
- All Class Providers and Participants must log in at the Front Desk upon each arrival at CCAC. Information will be maintained for potential contact tracing.
- When possible, all entrance and interior doors will be propped open, to limit touching of door handles.
- CCAC Staff, Class Providers, and Participants are required to wear face coverings while inside the building, except for one of the following reasons:
 - Facial coverings are not advisable for health reasons.
 - There is a functional reason not to wear a facial covering.
- Class Providers and Participants are encouraged to bring their own mats, bands, etc.

Sanitization

- CCAC Staff, Class Providers, and Participants are required to wash their hands or utilize hand sanitizer upon entry to facility.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the facility for CCAC Staff, Class Providers, and Participants.
- CCAC will provide cleaning products, EPA-approved disinfectants or disinfecting wipes for Participants to sanitize equipment they have used before and after class. Equipment cleaning will be backed up by Class Providers and CCAC Staff.
- CCAC Staff will routinely disinfect high-contact surfaces, desk workstations, restrooms, and equipment.

Signage

- At the main entrance, signs have been posted requiring social distancing and face coverings.
- Reminder signage has been posted throughout building about hand-washing, sanitization of equipment, social distancing, and face coverings.

Air Circulation

- CCAC has removed floor fans from all classrooms.
- When possible, all entrance and interior doors will be propped open to help with air circulation.

Check-on upon arrival at CCAC

- Class Providers/Participants must conduct self-assessment and not enter a facility if they are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- When participating in a class or camp, Participants may not arrive more than 10 minutes prior to class.
- Participants must exit the CCAC building upon completion of their class: no socializing or extra-curricular activities may take place inside CCAC building.
- At child-centric instruction, parents/guardians must wait in vehicle for pick-up.
