



## **Covid-19 Preparedness Measures and Requirements for Participation**

### **Vaccination, Face Coverings, and Facility**

- Per Ohio and CDC guidance, unvaccinated individuals are required to wear face coverings over their nose, mouth, and chin indoors and maintain at least 6' of social distancing, except for one of the following reasons:
  - Facial coverings are not advisable for health reasons.
  - There is a functional reason not to wear a facial covering.
- Class Providers teaching children are required to have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- CCAC's Lost and Found bins have been eliminated – items left after class will be disposed of.
- Class Providers and Participants are encouraged to bring their own mats, bands, etc.

### **Sanitization**

- CCAC Staff, Class Providers, and Participants are required to wash their hands or utilize hand sanitizer upon entry to facility.
- Hand sanitizer is available throughout the facility for CCAC Staff, Class Providers, and Participants.
- CCAC will provide cleaning products, EPA-approved disinfectants or disinfecting wipes for Participants to sanitize equipment they have used before and after class. Equipment cleaning will be backed up by Class Providers and CCAC Staff.
- CCAC Staff will routinely disinfect high-contact surfaces, desk workstations, restrooms, and equipment.

### **Signage**

- Reminder signage has been posted throughout building about hand-washing, sanitization of equipment, social distancing, and face coverings.

### **Check-in upon arrival at CCAC**

- Class Providers/Participants must conduct self-assessment and not enter a facility if they are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to COVID-19.
- All Class Providers and Participants must log in at the Front Desk upon each arrival at CCAC. Information will be maintained for potential contact tracing.
